ITINERARY :

Day 01: Arrival at Guwahati– Shillong (98 km/ Approx 3 hrs)

On arrival at Guwahati airport pickup and then proceed to Shillong the capital city of Meghalaya. On the way in Guwahati, visit Kamakhya Mandir, At the entrance of the Shillong visit Umiam Lake. Evening check into hotel.

Overnight stay in Shillong (D)

Day 02: Shillong - Cherrapunjee - Shillong (53km / Approx 2 hrs One way)

After breakfast drive to Cherrapunjee, the wettest place on the earth, for an awesome day trip. En-route visit the famous Elephant falls. At Sohra, stop at the Duwan Sing Syiem view point for mesmerizing views of the Hills. In Cherrapunjee be witness to the gorgeous Seven Sisters Falls and Nohkalikai Falls. Later take a soft cave walk inside the Mawsmi Cave. The limestone cave is a natural wonder with innumerable formations inside it. After lunch we drive to Shillong, then check into hotel.

Overnight stay in Shillong (B, D)

Day 03: Shillong – Mawlynnong – Dwaki – Shillong (116km / Approx 3:30 hrs Min one way)

After breakfast drive to Mawlynnong, the cleanest village in Asia, also known as 'God's own Garden'. With over 80 households, the village gives the ambiance of walking in a well-maintained park! You will also be acquainted to the Khasi lifestyle, their culture and economy.

A trek to the nearby Rewai Village is another interesting activity. Walk down almost 100 steps to witness nature's wonder, living-root bridge.

Later proceed to Dwaki, a village of the Jaintia Community whose prime occupation of fishing. The river is also famous for its crystal water, so clear that when seen from a distance, it appears as if the boat is floating in mid-air! The Umngot river is the natural boundary between Ri Pnar or Jaintia Hills with Hima Khyrim of Khasi hills over which is a single span suspension bridge was constructed. This is the gateway to Bangladesh where major export and import transactions take place. Enjoy an amazing country boat river ride. Drive up to the Bangladesh border gate (TAMABILA). then back to Shillong.

Overnight stay in Shillong (B, D)

Day 04: Shillong to Kaziranga (252 km / Approx 7 hrs)

After breakfast drive to Kaziranga, where wildlife roams fearlessly, where man and nature meets together. Enroute visit Mahamrutyunjay Temple. Then check into hotel. evening is free for Leisure.

Overnight stay in Kaziranga (B, D)

Day 05: Kaziranga

Today morning we experience a thrilling jeep safari at Kaziranga National Park for wildlife viewing. Then back to hotel. After breakfast, we visit Orchid Garden. The Orchid Park boasts of having more than 500 varieties of wild orchids, 132 species of sour fruits and leafy vegetables, 46 species of bamboo, 12 species of cane and many other plants along with various species of local fishes. Evening free for Leisure.

Overnight stay in Kaziranga (B, D)

Day 06: Kaziranga to Bomdila/Dirang (225 km / Approx 7 hrs)

After breakfast, we proceed to Dirang. Evening check into hotel.

Overnight stay in Dirang/Bomdila (B, D)

Day 07: Bomdila/Dirang to Tawang (175km / 6hrs)

After breakfast, drive to Tawang (10,000 ft). En-route witness the unique Dirang Valley famous for its monasteries & charming valleys. Also witness the snowcapped Sella Pass at 13700 ft, the Jaswant Garh War Memorial and Jung Falls. Jaswant Garh War Memorial : Legend has it that Jaswant (Mahavir Chakra Awardee(Posthumous) of 4th Battalion Garhwal Rifles), fought a lone battle against the invading Chinese during the 1962 war. His spirit is still believed to protect the place.

Sela Pass : @13700 ft, the Sela Pass is is snow-covered (full or partial) all through the year and has breath taking mystic views. Close to the Pass is the beautiful Sela Lake, a heart-shaped lake chiselled between the mountains, which intensifies the beauty of the region. The Lake is mostly frozen in winter. The Sela Pass is the main route to access Tawang town and is located 78 km before reaching Tawang.

Jung Falls : The Nuranang falls (original name) @6000 feet is located about 40 km before reaching Tawang is famed as one of the most stunning waterfalls in North East India. The falls height is about 100 meters. The legend about the waterfalls goes that it is named after a Monpa girl Nura who aided an Indian soldier during the 1962 Sino-Indian War.

Later visit the War Memorial commemorating the bravery of the Indian heroes of the Indo-China war of 1962. Witness the light & sound show (Subject to Operational) in the evening

Overnight in Tawang (B, D)

Day 08: Tawang Local sightseeing

Tawang is the beautiful land of the Monpa tribes. 'The Land of Dawn-lit Mountains' at 3500 mts gives you unparalleled purity of nature. After breakfast proceed for an excursion to Sangestar Lake (Madhuri Lake), Bum La Pass and China Border (subject to permission from Indian Army). Local sumo / similar vehicle will be available (6 to 7 person per vehicle)

The Sangestar Lake, or more popularly known as the Madhuri Lake, is about 20 kms from Tawang, en-route to the road leading to Bum La Pass. The lake is surrounded by the majestic snow-capped mountains and a marvelous valley offering spectacular views.

The Bum La Pass is one of the four officially agreed BPM (Border Personnel Meeting) point between Indian Army and People's Liberation Army of China for regular consultations and interactions between the two armies, which helps in defusing face-offs

Overnight stay at Tawang (B, D)

Day 09: Tawang to Dirang/Bomdila (134km / Approx 5hrs)

After breakfast visit the Tawang Monastery The Tawang Monastery, also known as the "GALDEN NAMGYEL LHATSE" is one of the largest Lamaseries of Mahayana sect in Asia and is the largest of its kind in India. The Monastery is 400 year old and is adorned with the 18 feet high statue of Lord Buddha. It stands at 10,000 feet amidst the exotic Himalayan ranges and overlooks the Tawang Chu valley. Later on proceed to Bomdila. Evening check into Hotel.

Overnight stay in Dirang/Bomdila (B, D)

Day 10: Dirang to Guwahati (377 km / Approx 10 hrs)

After breakfast, we drive to Guwahati. Evening free for Leisure.

Day 11: Guwahati Airport to Dimpaur airport

After breakfast we proceed to Guwahati airport to Dimapur airport by flight. On Arrival at Dimapur airport around 13:15 pickup and proceed to Kohima. the capital of the Indian state Nagaland, On 1st Dec, 1963 Nagaland became part of India. Once we reach at Kohima, will visit Kohima Cathedral (Church)- one of the biggest cathedrals in North East India (if time permit) Later on check into hotel.

Overnight stay at Kohima (B, D)

Day 12: Kohima to Imphal

After breakfast visit, Kisama Village (horn bill village). Later proceed to Imphal. Imphal: Capital city of Manipur, it lies in the central part of the state in the Manipur River valley at an elevation of 2,500 feet (760 mt). Imphal was the seat of the kings of Manipur before the region fell under British rule. Visit *Ima Bazaar – the World’s only All Women run Market. *In the evening Govindjee Temple (Infront of our hotel) – the largest Hindu, Vaishnav temple in Imphal city.

Overnight stay at Imphal (B, D)

Day 13: Imphal sightseeing

After breakfast proceed to visit *Loktak Lake – the largest fresh water floating lake in North – East India *Indian National Army Museum – the only official museum dedicated to the Second World War in Manipur, it’s focus is primarily on the rise of the INA and on the role and activities of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose in particular.

Overnight stay at Imphal (B, D)

Day 14: Imphal to Agartala

After breakfast visit Kangla Fort – which was the traditional seat of the rulers of Manipur and a symbol of Manipur’s glory, Then proceed to Agartala by flight , Agartala is the capital city of the Indian state of Tripura, and is one of the largest cities in northeast India , The city is the seat of the Government of Tripura. It is located on the banks of the Haora River, near the Bangladesh border. Arrive at Agartala around 15:45 pickup and proceed to visit Jagannath Temple. After proceed to hotel.

Overnight stay at Agartala (B, D)

Day 15: Agartala sightseeing

After breakfast proceed for local sightseeing Ujjayanta Palace – former palace of the Kingdom of Tripura built in the Indo - Saracenic style of architecture. Neer Mahal – a former royal palace built by Maharaja of Tripura Kingdom. Tripura Sundari Temple.

Overnight stay at Agartala (B, D)

Day 16: Drop at Agartala airport

After breakfast check out from hotel and Drop at airport for Return Journey. Tour end with Happy Memories of Tour (B)
