Itinerary:

Day 1: Arrive London

Arrive in London – City of Queen’s land. On arrival visit the Tower of London, where we will see the 'Kohinoor Diamond'. You can also photograph yourself with the 'Yeomen Warders', the ceremonial guardians of the Tower of London. Next visit the famous Madame Tussaud's wax museum. This museum houses a unique collection of world's largest wax works of famous personalities, including India's top leaders and film stars. Overnight stay in London. (B, L, D)

Day 2: London Local Sightseeing

We proceed to enjoy city orientation tour covering Hyde Park, Big Ben, Westminster Abbey, Piccadilly Circus, River Thames, Houses of Parliament, Trafalgar Square, Tower Bridge. Admire panoramic views over the Thames River, Big Ben and other landmarks on this 30-minute flight – The London Eye Ride - Europe’s tallest observation wheel. Free time for shopping at the famous Oxford / Bakers Street. (If time Permits). Overnight stay in London. (B, L, D)

Day 3: London – Paris

Board the highly acclaimed Eurostar to cross the English Channel from London to Paris. Arrive at Paris - Fashion Capital of the world, dazzling, shining & Romantic city, famous for high quality gastronomy and world class clothing brands. One of the most beautiful cities in the World. Upon arrival visit the Paris's most famous and awaited attraction of your trip, The Eiffel Tower - World’s most recognizable landmark, Masterpiece of modern architecture. The most enthralling landmark of Paris. Take the elevator and access the top level of Eiffel Tower from where you can get fantastic views of Paris city (Top Level subject to operation/ Available). Paris city orientation tour to see the most famous landmarks. Travel past the Champs Elysses, L'Arc de Triomphe and Place de la Concorde. Enjoy the Seine River cruise in the evening. Overnight stay in Paris (B, L, D)

Day 4: Paris – Versailles – Paris

Today we visit the Versailles palace – a UNESCO World Heritage Site, whose origins date back to the seventeenth century, was successively a hunting lodge, a seat of power and from the nineteenth century, a museum. Here we see the State apartments and the magnificent Hall of Mirrors. Later we visit Louvre Museum where you can see the famous Monalisa Painting. Overnight stay in Paris. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Paris – Amsterdam

Today we proceed to Amsterdam – the capital city of Netherlands with more number of canals than roads, also known for its artistic heritage, elaborate canal system and narrow houses. Visit Keukenhof tulip gardens – beautiful Tulip gardens where we enjoy photography at various flower shows, statues,

pavilions, beautiful ponds and fields. Enjoy Canal Cruise in Amsterdam. Overnight stay in Rotterdam. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Amsterdam – Brussels – Luxembourg

Today we proceed to Brussels – capital city of Belgium. Upon arrival, we enjoy Brussels city, in the orientation tour we see Grand Place – the central square, Town Hall, Guild Houses – Gothic building from the middle ages, Monument of Everard Serclaes – the hero who liberated the city during 14th century war and Belgium’s favourite Manneken Pis Statue – a small bronze statue of a little peeing boy. In the afternoon we proceed to Luxembourg – a small European country famed for its fortified medieval old town situated on cliffs. Upon arrival, we explore the city of Luxembourg by a tram. Sit back and relax as the tram takes you to some of the most notable and impressive areas of the city. Overnight stay in Luxembourg. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Luxembourg – Titisee – Rhine Falls – Lucerne

Today we drive through the Black forest region- a mountainous region in Germany, known for its dense evergreen forests and picturesque villages. Here we visit Cuckoo clock shop at Titisee. After a scenic journey through black forest region we visit yet another natural beauty at Rhine Falls, Schaffhausen (Neuhausen) – the most powerful waterfall in Europe. Here we enjoy Boat ride for a spectacular view of the falls. Later we proceed to Lucerne, Switzerland – a beautiful city in the heartland of Switzerland. Overnight stay in Lucerne. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Lucerne – Mt. Titlis – Lucerne

Today proceed to Mt Titlis, one of the highest peaks in central Switzerland. As you journey to Mt Titlis in two different cable cars, you will be amazed as the scenery changes from green meadows, scenic lakes to snow clad mountains. The last leg of this journey will be in the world's first rotating cable car called the 'Titlis Rotair'. Visit the Ice Grotto and enjoy a ride on the thrilling Ice Flyer ride and Snow sliding (subject to operation). If weather permits, you can take a stroll on the latest attraction at Mt Titlis – The Cliff Walk. Next enjoy an orientation tour of Lucerne where you will see Lion Monument and the Kapellbrücke (wooden bridge). Here you will have some free time to shop for the famous Swiss Watches, knives and chocolates. Later enjoy a scenic cruise on the serene waters of Lake Lucerne. Overnight stay in Lucerne. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Lucerne – Jungfrauoch – Lucerne

Begin this day with a visit to Jungfrauoch – The Top of Europe, for a memorable encounter with snow and ice. Arrive at Grindelwald terminal to board a fastest & modern attraction "Eiger Express" high speed cable car to reach Eiger Glacier railway station. Enjoy cogwheel train ride, which takes you to a height of 3500 meters to reach Jungfrauoch – Europe's highest railway station! Experience the magic of the mountains and visit the Ice Palace on top of the tallest glacier in the Alps. Take an elevator to the Sphinx observatory deck. Later proceed to Eiger Glacier by cogwheel train to board "Eiger Express" a high-speed cable car till Grindelwald Terminal. Later drive through Interlaken city. Overnight stay in Lucerne. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Lucerne – Vaduz – Wattens – Innsbruck

Toy Train Ride through Vaduz, Swarovski Crystal World, Walking tour of Innsbruck Proceed to Liechtenstein - one of the smallest countries in the world. Take a Toy Train ride in capital city Vaduz. Continuing our journey to Wattens in Austria, you will visit the Crystal Museum of Swarovski. Moving on to Innsbruck, you will see the Golden Roof and Helblinghaus – a building resembling a Wedding Cake. Overnight stay in Innsbruck. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Innsbruck – Venice – Bologna

Today proceed to Venice – the city of romance. Board your Vaporetto water bus to reach the Venice Island. Experience one of the most truly Venetian moments on a Gondola ride. Glide through the canals

in your Gondola and see the hidden places only accessible by Gondola. On your orientation tour of Venice see the Doge's Palace, Bell Tower, Bridge of Sighs – which served as a link between the Doge's Palace and the New Prisons, St Marks Square and the Basilica. Later make your way to Bologna. Overnight stay in Bologna. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Bologna – Vatican City – Rome

Proceed to the Vatican City – the smallest country in the world. Take a photo-stop at World renowned Vatican Square. Visit the holy basilica of St. Peter's – famous for The Pieta Sculpture and home of architectural and artistic masterpieces, which will you spellbound. Later proceed to Rome - 'The Eternal City' as ancient inhabitants believed it would go on forever. On arrival enjoy walking city orientation tour see the Roman Forum – an impressive sprawl of ruins which was the political and commercial hub of the Roman Empire, then take a brief stop at Trevi Fountain – Rome's most famous fountain, known for its legend that states if you throw a coin in the water, you will return to Rome someday. See the Circus Maximus – a Roman chariot racing stadium and mass entertainment venue of ancient Rome followed by the famous Piazza Venezia, a square located in the heart of Rome and photo stop at Colosseum from outside. Overnight stay in Rome. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Rome – Siena – Pisa

Today depart for Sienna – a Gem of Tuscany, take orientation tour covering Piazza del Campo, Duomo di Siena, Piazza Salimbeni – The oldest bank in the world. Later proceed to Pisa. On arrival enjoy city orientation tour includes Square of Miracles, Baptistry, Cathedral and Leaning tower of Pisa. Overnight stay in Pisa (B, L, D)

Day 14: Pisa - Milan - Departure from Milan

Proceed to Milan - famous for its extraordinary architecture, historic & cultural landmarks and mecca of fashion. On arrival enjoy photo stop at Duomo di Milano – a masterpiece of gothic architecture. Later proceed to airport to board the flight for your home town. Tour Concludes. (B, L)
